



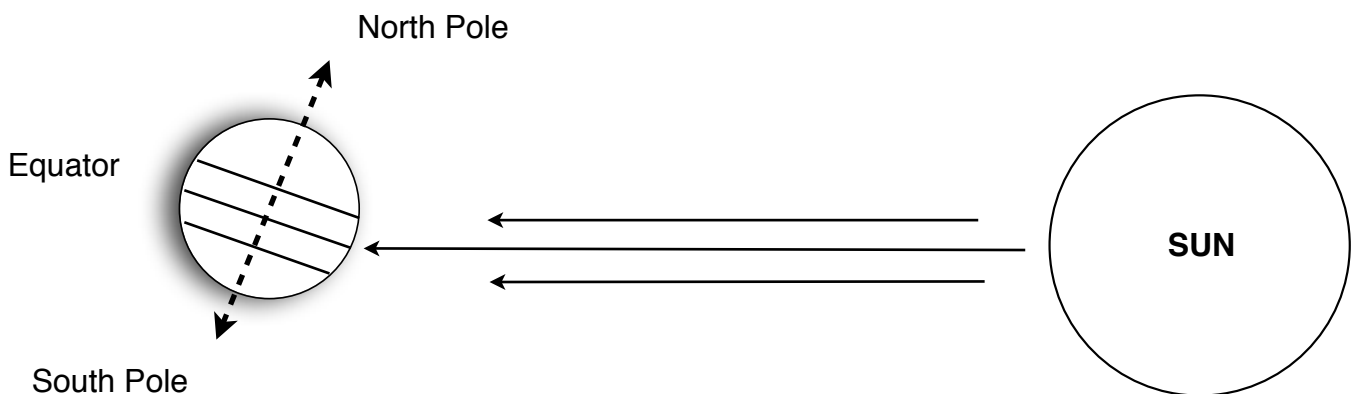

AUTUMN EQUINOX

What happens?

The sun moves north from the southern hemisphere and appears directly over the equator on 20th March.

Day and night is nearly equal in length.



Will this affect the tides?

Yes. As the sun is over the equator, its gravitational strength on the earth is stronger; therefore the tides will be higher.

Best fishing times

Round full moon 13-16 March and new moon 29-31 March 2014.
