

ORCHID COUNT IN STEENBOK 2024

DATE: 30 & 31 October

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3 orchid species were Identified in Steenbok Nature Reserve. *Bonatea speciosa* (L.f.) Willd, *Eulophia speciosa* and *Satyrium princeps Bolus*. The areas are West of the tennis courts, Kingfisher Creek, Land's End and in the grass area between the common and Links Drive.

NOTE: *Satyrium princeps Bolus* are a protected species and also a threatened species as much of its former habitat has been lost to coastal housing development.

Orchid species West of the tennis courts

Bonatea speciosa (L.f.) Willd - 20 observed.

Satyrium princeps Bolus - 50 observed.

Orchid species adjacent to Nature's Walk in Kingfisher Creek

Bonatea speciosa (L.f.) Willd - 8 observed.

Satyrium princeps Bolus - 27 observed.

Orchid species at Land's End

Bonatea speciosa (L.f.) Willd 25 observed.

Satyrium princeps Bolus 0 observed.

Eulophia speciosa - 2 observed.

Orchid species in the grass area between the Tow path and Links Drive

Bonatea speciosa (L.f.) Willd 1 observed.

Eulophia speciosa 12 observed.

Satyrium princeps Bolus 0 observed.
